1. Meeting was called to order at 7:18 p.m.
2. Motion to approve minutes from previous meeting by Marilyn Bowers, second by Jonathan Newberry. Motion passed.
3. Public input not on agenda: none
4. Other business not on agenda: Bob Colvin mentioned the sanitary survey, which would take place on July 19. He recommended putting the Quarry Rd. tank back into service, which would allow the water department to have more storage capacity in case of emergency. They could run the water from TASS to the tank instead of purchasing from South Blount, which costs more than TASS. The board discussed confined space training for the employees, along with other safety training. The city will no longer be able to get inmate labor since many of the State inmates at the Blount County Jail are being sent back to the state prison due to overcrowding and the inmates who are on work release outside the jail will be needed to do work inside the jail.
5. Water loss: 36% for the month of May. Part of the loss was due to filling up lines and flushing lines at Parks Ferry.

6. There were 12 new customers, 2 new taps and 10 finals for June.

7. Motion to adjourn by Shane Rogers, second by Mike Bailey. Motion passed.
